

Zimbabwe has 16 official languages

English, Shona, Ndebele,
Xhosa, Tswana, Chewa,
Chibarwe, Kalanga, Sign Language,
Sotho, Tonga, Kaisan,
Nambia, Ndaou, Shangani
Venda.

(English, Shona and Ndebele are the most widely used. Shona is spoken by 70% of the Zimbabwe population, while Ndebele by 20%. Both are Bantu languages. English is the first language of only 2% of the population.)
