In Zimbabwe, many women who give birth to disabled children are abandoned by their husbands who leave them with the sole responsibility of taking care of the children which is financially challenging.

In spite of the Covid restrictions, this project is supporting women from all walks of life who find it difficult, if not impossible, to attend any social gatherings, because of the discrimination and stigma attached to the conditions of their children.

The project has been meeting these needs by equipping and developing mothers and their children to have independence. It is bringing mothers of disabled children together to share, pray, learn, and fellowship together, and encourage each other through their stories.
