FAQs

Why is Feed the Minds closing?

Feed the Minds has made the difficult decision to close after 60 years of operations due to financial constraints. Feed the Minds holds a continued commitment to improving the lives of marginalised communities through education and literacy but looking at the long-term financial sustainability of the charity, the board have decided to close at this point where it can be done in a responsible and managed manner.

When will Feed the Minds officially close?

Feed the Minds will officially cease operations on 30 April 2025.

What will happen to the existing projects?

All current projects will be completed or, wherever possible, transitioned to alternative management before the closure. We are working closely with our partners and donors to ensure a smooth transition and minimise disruption to the communities we support.

Will Feed the Minds continue accepting donations?

We are no longer accepting donations. As Feed the Minds concludes its journey, we extend our heartfelt gratitude to the supporters, donors, and partners who have made our work possible over the decades.

What will happen to Feed the Minds' assets and funds when it closes?

When Feed the Minds closes, any remaining assets and funds will be distributed in accordance with our legal and ethical obligations.

How can I obtain records or information previously held by Feed the Minds?

If you have personal materials, such as photos or documents provided to Feed The Minds, and need to retrieve them, please contact us as soon as possible. In line with the Data Protection Act 2018, personal data and records will only be retained for as long as necessary for the purposes for which they were collected. After our closure, any such materials will be securely destroyed, unless they are archived as historical materials with a designated organisation for long-term preservation.

What will happen to Feed the Minds' online presence and resources?

Our website and social media channels will remain accessible until our official closure on 30 April 2025.
