Notes:

The call and response pattern shown in this piece is common throughout West African singing. This allows for spontaneous improvisation and building communal connection.

When offering this piece in worship, leaders may introduce variations in melody, text, or rhythm while maintaining the core spiritual identity. Communal responses typically remain more consistent, providing a stable foundation for the leader's creative expressions.
